HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

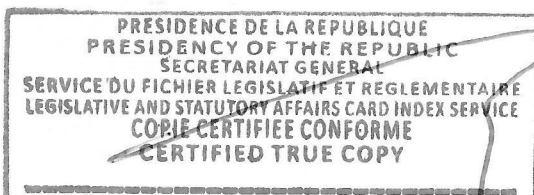
Article 1: The following persons are, with effect from the date of signature of this order, appointed to the Unity Palace Infirmary:
